Duties and Responsibilities:

- Overall repair and maintenance of all VGT machines.
- All troubleshooting, replacing and installing parts on electrical and mechanical VGT machines in accordance with gaming regulations.
- Follow all Casino policies and procedures for equipment operations and repair.
- Produce daily reports for parts and inventory.

Knowledge and Skills Required:

- Minimum of one year basic electronics skills.
- Able to work with digital multimeter.
- Computer skills to include trouble shooting, component repair and networking basics.

Physical Demands

While performing the duties of this job, the associate is regularly required to stand; use hands and fingers to handle or feel; reach with hands and arms; talk and hear.

The associate frequently is required to walk and stoop, kneel, crouch, or crawl. The associate is occasionally required to sit, climb, or balance. The associate must be able to lift, move, and control 50 pounds with the aid of dollies and tools; able to lift and move 40 pounds short distances without mechanical aid and frequently lift and/or move 10 pounds.

Specific vision abilities required by this job include close vision, depth perception, and ability to adjust focus.

While performing standard duties associated with the position, the associate will be exposed to a smoking environment with noise levels ranging from quiet to loud. The associate will also occasionally be exposed to adverse weather conditions. Working conditions also occasionally consist of moving and working around the customers of casinos.

- High school equivalent education is required
- Trade school certification for PC hardware preferred
- May also be required to apply for Indian Gaming licenses to work with various casino locations and tribes.
