Position Description:

The Test Engineer works with Project Management, software development, and hardware development teams to validate and verify VGT software and hardware products.

Position Summary:

- Extract test requirements from product functional specification documents, or via discussions with software developers and project managers
- Design, implement, and maintain manual test plans
- Execute manual and automated test plans
- Enter defect reports into defect database
- Generate test reports to summarize results of a test sweep
- Assist in recreating problems reported from the field
- May assist with implementation and maintenance of automated test plans or test scripts
- May assist in maintenance or assembly of VGT Player Terminals
- May assist with technical writing of documents for internal or external use, such as internal procedures, Field Service Bulletins, or user's manuals
- May assist with creation and maintenance of SharePoint or other intranet web pages
- Travel to customer sites with other VGT associates, or travel alone to other VGT offices
- Rely on instructions and pre-established guidelines to plan and accomplish goals
- Work under immediate supervision
- Can work on more than one project simultaneously

- A limited degree of creativity and latitude is expected
